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One 2 One peer mentors are paired with students in the WAMS and RHS vocational studies program to increase participation and enjoyment in our school communities. Mentors spend one lunch period per week hanging out with their peer buddy helping to build social skills. There are also many extracurricular opportunities available

In School Activities include lunch or in-school projects. You may help your buddy participate in a variety of school activities or simply hang out and have lunch. You will help your buddy build the skills needed to make and keep friends and to have more opportunities to participate in school related activities.

Extra-Curricular Activities include attending school sports, joining groups and clubs. Extra curricular activities also include things beyond the school environment like going to the movies, mall or local restaurants.
